
Conflict of Interest Review and Declaration

Chairman Burton read the Board's Conflict of Interest Review and Declaration statement and asked Board members if they have an actual conflict or appearance of a conflict of interest with any items that were known to be coming before the Board and, if so, does any Board member having a conflict wish to recuse him/herself from deliberating and voting on the matter. All Board members present verbalized that they do not have a conflict.

The Board considered going into closed session to discuss a personnel matter. Ms. Wagstaff made a motion for the Board to go into closed session per G.S. § 143-318.11(a): (3) to consult with an attorney employed or retained by the public body in order to preserve the attorney-client privilege between the attorney and the public body, which privilege is hereby acknowledged; and (6) to consider the qualifications, competence, performance, character, fitness, conditions of appointment, and/or conditions of initial employment of an individual employee. Board Member Miller seconded the motion and the Board approved without objection.

The Board returned to open session and Chairman Burton motioned to recess the meeting. The Board unanimously approved.
